Navarro College Faculty Rank System:

Faculty rank to be determined by meeting one of the following three statuses.

Professor:

- Current appointment to full-time faculty position at Navarro College
- At least five years of Navarro College qualified experience (adjunct at Navarro experience at a rate of 10 courses taught equal one year)
- Degree appropriate for your position plus post-degree experience that meets the following:
 - o Doctorate+ 5 years of related experience or
 - o Master's + 9 years of related experience and one of the following:
 - 1. 9 credit hours of postgraduate work beyond the Master's degree or
 - Other professional development activities commensurate with the time and effort ordinarily associated with completion of at least 9 credit hours of postgraduate work (3 @48 hours=144 hours). See guidelines for calculating hours. Documentation of the experience must be submitted to Human Resources.

Associate Professor:

- Current appointment to full-time faculty position at Navarro College
- One of the following earned degrees:
 - 1. Master's degree
 - 2. Doctorate

Or

Degree/license/certificate appropriate for your position and experience that meets one of the following:

- 1. Professional License/Certification+17 years of related experience+ 4 years at Navarro
- 2. Bachelors + 13 years of related experience + 4 years at Navarro

Assistant Professor:

- Current appointment to full-time faculty position at Navarro College and one of the following:
 - o Bachelor's degree

or

o License/certificate appropriate for your position

The guidelines:

- o 9 postgraduate credit hours is equivalent to 3 courses at 48 contact hours each for a total of 144 contact hours.
- Any equivalent combination of postgraduate hours and professional development activities below can be used to meet this requirement under the assumption that each completed postgraduate course is equivalent to 48 contact hours of professional development.
- o May calculate professional development equivalent to the required 9 credit hours from the time hired at Navarro College.
- o Professional development activities which may be included:
 - 1 hour credit per contact hour for attending training on campus (example: LMS training, etc. Workshops attended during faculty convocation may be included if they were designed to enhance knowledge or skills, but hours spent in general meetings which occur during convocation are not included.).
 - 2 hours credit per contact hour for attending professional conference/training activities (example: state, regional or national conference).
 - 10 hours credit for each professional conference presentation at a regional, state, or national conference.
 - 4 credit hours per contact hour for presenting on-campus workshop/professional development activities. (These workshops must be scheduled and approved by the Vice President of Academic Affairs.
 - 1 hour credit per contact hour for independent study to acquire additional knowledge/skills/abilities related to your professional responsibilities and other unique opportunities with a maximum of 6 hours annually for independent study. (Must be relevant to your teaching assignment and requires preapproval of the appropriate Dean.)

The process:

- 1. Download the Faculty Rank Packet
- 2. Completely fill out the packet and attach all documentation
- 3. Submit the packet to the Human Resources Office
- 4. Human Resources will evaluate the information provided
- 5. FAEC will review and submit back to HR their decision
- 6. Human Resources will notify the faculty member of the decision made
